Thank You: We appreciate you taking time out of your busy schedules to meet with us to touch base on how your children are doing. Conferences went really well... we're excited to jump into 2nd quarter!

Family Reading Night: Our annual reading event is this Thursday at 6:00pm. Please see the enclosed flyer for more information. We hope to see you there!

Homework I: Several students are forgetting to turn in their homework each day. Please remind your student about this important responsibility.

Homework II: We are continuing to receive homework that has not been corrected at home. Please take a few moments to go over your child's homework with them nightly to ensure that they have completed it correctly.

Math Facts: Students should, at a minimum, be working on their math facts on Wednesday nights as part of their homework. Ideally, we would like them to practice several times a week. Frequent, repetitious studying of math facts is extremely important.

Math Reinforcement: There are two online math support programs that we are now utilizing in third grade. If your student enjoys trying to beat the clock when practicing their math facts, we recommend Oswego Math Magician. If your student prefers to practice without being timed, we recommend Fact Monster. You can find links to the sites on our web site (url is located on the front of this newsletter). Flashcards are ok to use, also. **Leaf Reading**: There will be a reading log sent home every month. Logging home reading minutes is completely optional. If your child chooses to do this, they will receive extra credit in reading. Instructions are on the leaf sheet. Please email your child's EA if you have any questions.

Volunteering with Siblings: We understand that there has been some questions regarding JA's policy on parents volunteering while they have siblings with them. JA's policy is that siblings are not allowed to accompany parents while they are volunteering at the school, except if the parent is volunteering in the cafeteria/commons during lunch or if they are volunteering for Mileage Club. Parents are generally allowed to bring siblings to certain activities (Geo Bowl, Roman Days, and usually class parties) if they are only observing, taking photos, etc. Please let us know if you have any questions.
